



**State Board of Education Resolution**  
**To Approve a Waiver of the Domicile Requirement for an Excepted Service Employee of**  
**the State Board of Education**  
**SR17-9**

**WHEREAS**, the DC Office of Human Resources and the DC Office of the Attorney General have informed the State Board that employees of the State Board must serve at will in the Excepted Service and not in the Career Service;

**WHEREAS**, District of Columbia law requires Excepted Service employees to reside in the District of Columbia and the SBOE believes that all employees of the State Board should be District residents as their work requires an intimate knowledge of the District, its neighborhoods and its people;

**WHEREAS**, the position of the Staff Assistant has been held by the same individual for ten years as a Career Service position;

**WHEREAS**, the State Board is required to convert all Career Service employees to the Excepted Service,

**WHEREAS**, a waiver of the domicile requirement can be issued for cause;

**WHEREAS**, the residency requirement of the Excepted Service presents an undue burden on the individual staff member currently serving as Staff Assistant; and,

**WHEREAS**, the State Board believes that this waiver should be granted only in unique circumstances.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the State Board will approve a waiver of the domiciliary requirement in the District of Columbia for the Staff Assistant position.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED** that the waiver granted by the State Board of Education only applies to the current Staff Assistant, Jamikka Briscoe.
